- To complement its Medical Training Programme, ABUAD built an ultra-modern 400-bed Multi-System Hospital which was commissioned on October 20, 2017. The Hospital is populated with the most modern and sophisticated medical equipment and employed the best of hands that have made it the Hospital of first choice in Africa. This has stood it out as a clear leader and the toast of its peers in Africa.
- No wonder, Dr. Yemi Johnson, the Chief Medical Director of First Cardiology Consultants, Lagos, had this to say about the Hospital: **"This is my first visit to Ekiti and the ABUAD Hospital was my first stop. This is really impressive. I can say without any equivocation that this hospital has more high-tech medical equipment than all the hospitals in Lagos put together. This is most certainly the best equipped hospital in Sub-Saharan Africa"**.
- One amazing thing about the Multi-System Hospital is that even though it is equipped with state-of-the-art medical equipment, the rates are much lower than what people think.
- Availability of a Helipad certified by the Ministry of Aviation, with which patients could be conveniently ferried from any part of the country to the Hospital.

### 8. ABUAD INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH PARK

- As an innovative University that set out to make a difference, Afe Babalola University conceptualized the establishment of a 124 units of small, medium and large-scale industries in the Industrial Research Park, an



- amalgamation of industry with University to promote innovation, research, industrial development, employment and generate income for the industry, University community, the State and the Federal Government.
- On January 25, 2018, the revered Ooni of Ife, His Imperial Majesty, Oba Adeyeye Enitan Ogunwusi, Ojaja II, turned the sod of Industrial Park. This singular event marked the beginning of Industrial Revolution in Nigeria and since then, nobody has doubted the University's ability to do its judging by the streak of successes ABUAD has recorded since it came into existence slightly over 15 years ago.
  - The first phase of the 124-unit Industrial Research Park took off on Monday, June 21, 2021 with the commissioning of the University's Independent Power Project, IPP, and the foundation laying of nine other industries within the Industrial Park Complex.

**9. DRUG RESEARCH**  
Beginning from 2019, the University's Bogoro Research Institute in concert with ABUAD Multi-System Hospital (AMSH), the College of Pharmacy and the Herbal Factory sited at the ABUAD Industrial Research Park, shot to international prominence by developing a herbal remedy called *Virucidine* for the treatment of the dreaded Covid-19, a disease which changed the political, economic, health and the education equation of the world for the better part of 2020. It has also developed a herb-based therapy called AB-MaL, a cheaper, more readily available and affordable medication for malaria. ABUAD's other intervention areas of health include ageing, cancer and benign prostate hyperplasia.
